

TOPICAL LOSARTAN IN CORNEAL SCARRING AND OTHER EYE DISEASES



Compounded losartan eye drops are being explored as **a potential treatment for corneal scarring - particularly after injuries, infections, or surgeries.**

What is it?

Losartan is an Angiotensin II Receptor Blocker (ARB) commonly prescribed as a tablet to treat hypertension and nephropathy. When taken orally, insignificant drug amounts reach the cornea. However, eye drop formulations are being studied in fibrosis management.

Corneal Mechanism of Action:

When administered ophthalmically, losartan **inhibits myofibroblast activity** (cells responsible for disorganized collagen) **via TGF- β signaling interference.**

Clinical Applications:

Topical losartan is being studied for its **potential to prevent or reverse corneal scarring** caused by:

- **Traumatic injuries**
- **Microbial infections**
- **Post-surgical complications**
- **Persistent corneal epithelial defects**
- **Thermal/chemical burns**

Is it a standard treatment?

While losartan is a well established hypertension medication, **ophthalmic formulations are showing promising research and are only available from a compounding pharmacy.**
